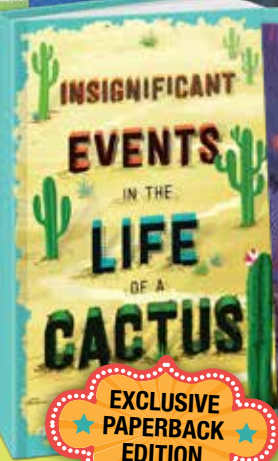

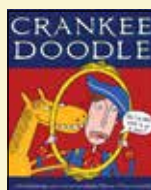


Pete the Kitty and the Groovy Playdate
